

Yamaha MO6/MO8 Multi Part Editor V2.2.2 for Mac

Release Notes

Thank you for using Yamaha products.

MO6/MO8 Multi Part Editor for Mac is a utility software program for the MO6/MO8 (henceforth referred to as “Editor”). When the MO6/MO8 is used in Multi mode, the software can be used to visually edit various parameters such as Part parameter (Volume, Pan, EG, Cutoff) and effects.

You can send the edited data to the MO6/MO8, as well as read data from the MO6/MO8 for editing.

This software can be used on its own as an independent editor, as well as with DAW software that is compatible with Studio Connections and the Recall feature.

Before installing:

Ensure that the latest Studio Manager is installed on your computer.

How to check you're the current version:

After starting up the Editor, go to the [HELP] menu -> [Version Information].
