## Minimum System Requirements

## Installing the application

1. After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click a following file.  
Install MOXF6\_MOXF8 Remote Tools.exe
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.

## For users of Windows 10

**Starting the application:**

Click "All apps" in the Start menu to see the full list of applications. You can start the application by clicking the icon.

**Uninstalling the application:**

1. Click "Settings" in the Start menu to call up the Settings window. In the Settings window, click "System" > "Apps and features."
2. Click the "Uninstall" button for the application.

**For users of Windows 8****Starting the application:**

Once the application is successfully installed, an icon of the application will be in your Windows 8 Start screen. You can start the application by clicking the icon.

**NOTE**

If the icon is not listed, right-click an empty area of the Start screen and select "All apps." Then select the application icon from the application list.

**Uninstalling the application:**

1. Right-click the application you wish to remove in the Windows 8 Start screen. If it's not listed, right click an empty area of the screen and select "All apps."
2. A check will be placed on the application you selected. Select the "Uninstall" option that appears at the bottom of the screen.
